| Sydney Turpentine Ironbark Forest | EEC – TSC CEEC – EPBC | Currently occurs at Park |
| Coastal Saltmarsh of the Sydney Basin Bioregion | EEC – TSC | Currently occurs at Park |
| Swamp Oak Floodplain Forest | EEC – TSC | Currently occurs at Park |
| <i>Wilsonia backhousei</i> | V – TSC | Currently occurs at Park |
| <i>Dillwynia tenuifolia</i> | V – TSC | Single plant present in the Brickpit, origin unknown |
| <i>Acacia pubescens</i> | V – TSC | Single plant present at northern end of the Waterbird Refuge, Badu Mangroves. Located in a planted garden bed, origin unknown, shrub is >10 years old. |
| Grey Mangrove <i>Avicennia marina</i> | PMV – FM | Currently occurs at Park |
| River Mangrove <i>Aegiceras corniculatum</i> | PMV – FM | Currently occurs at Park |
| Green and Golden Bell Frog <i>Litoria aurea</i> | E – TSC V – EPBC | Currently occurs at Park |
| White-fronted Chat <i>Epthianura albifrons</i> | V – TSC EP – TSC | Currently occurs at Park |
| Little Bent-winged Bat <i>Miniopterus australis</i> | V – TSC | Currently occurs at Park |
| Eastern Bent-winged Bat <i>Miniopterus orianae oceanensis</i> | V – TSC | Currently occurs at Park |
| Grey-headed Flying-fox <i>Pteropus poliocephalus</i> | V – TSC V – EPBC | Frequently seen flying over / feeding within the Park in small numbers. No roost sites (camps) |

| Australasian Bittern <i>Botaurus poiciloptilus</i> | V – TSC | Individuals recorded on occasion at Narawang Wetland |
| Freckled Duck <i>Stictonetta naevosa</i> | V – TSC M – EPBC | Individuals recorded on occasion at the Waterbird Refuge |
| Black-tailed Godwit <i>Limosa limosa</i> | V – TSC | Last recorded late 1990s at Newington Nature Reserve wetland and the Waterbird Refuge |
| Swift Parrot <i>Lathamus discolor</i> | E – TSC E – EPBC | Last recorded 1991 in the Bicentennial Park area |
| Grass Owl <i>Tyto capensis</i> | V – TSC | Last recorded 1982 at a wetland along Bennelong Road |
| Black-chinned Honeyeater <i>Melithreptus gularis gularis</i> | V – TSC | Last recorded 1940s |
| Broad-billed Sandpiper <i>Limicola falcinellus</i> | V – TSC | Historical record |
| Great Knot <i>Calidris tenuirostris</i> | V – TSC | Historical record |
| Little Tern <i>Strema albifrons</i> | E – TSC | Historical record |
| Listed migratory birds | M – EPBC | 31 species regularly recorded at Park, including breeding populations of some species |
| Newington Nature Reserve | NR – NPW | Managed by Sydney Olympic Park Authority under the terms of an agreement with Department of Environment, Climate Change & Water, and in accordance with the Newington Nature Reserve Plan of Management and the specific requirements of the SOPA Act. |
