

Sydney Olympic Park is unquestionably Sydney's most diverse and flexible event precinct, offering an expansive range of indoor and outdoor spaces for meetings, conferences, cocktail parties, exhibitions and product launches incentives and special events.

- Sydney Olympic Park is home to 10 business event venues offering over 100 different indoor and outdoor spaces, all in the one location.
- The Park has the capacity to accommodate conferences, conventions, meetings, seminars, training days
 workshops, special events, gala dinners, cocktail parties, product launches, incentives, trade and consumer
 exhibitions and weddings.
- The Park is capable of catering for small groups of 10 to large groups of 21,000.
- In 2014, 47% of all events held at the Park were business events.
- In the last five years, the Park has attracted close to 4.5 million business visitors to more than 13,000 business events.
- Sydney Olympic Park is home to Sydney's largest exhibition facility, offering over 32,000sqm of pillarless exhibition space.

ANZ Stadium

- Purpose built to excite, inspire, motivate and celebrate in spectacular style, and is ideally located within walking distance of ample parking, public transport and hotels.
- Offering 15 indoor and outdoor function rooms with flexible design options, accommodating up to 850 banquet style, 1,500 for cocktails, 1,500 theatre and 600 cabaret style with plenty of options for breakout spaces.
- Floor to ceiling windows allow for plenty of natural light in all rooms and spectacular views to the iconic main arena and Sydney Olympic Park precinct.

Aquatic Centre

- A venue with a difference poolside cocktail or dinner functions for up to 2,000 people at the waters edge.
- Function entertainment has included a floating ice rink with an ice dancing display, synchronized swimmers, daring 10 metre diving displays, pyrotechnics, laser lights or a water spectacular with jet skis and a hovercraft in the main pool.
- The training pool floor can be raised to a level of 1 inch and was used for a swimwear launch where it appeared that the models were walking on water.
- The outdoor leisure garden provides a tranquil location for cocktail parties, Aussie barbecues, family fun days or any other themed event.

Novotel and Hotel Ibis

Sydney Showground

- A distinct feature of Sydney Showground is The Dome, which combined with Exhibition Hall 2, 3 & 4 and the new multi-purpose venue (Exhibition Hall 5 & 6) provides over 32,000sqm of clear space.
